FIRE DEPARTMENT EMERGENCY SERVICES

- I. Fire Suppression
 - a. Four Fire Stations
 - b. 12 Engine and 6 Ladder Companies assigned to three shifts
 - c. 104 personnel assigned

- II. Emergency Medical Services
 - a. Four Fire Stations
 - b. 18 ALS Rescue Companies
 - c. 76 personnel assigned

- III. All Fire Suppression and EMS personnel are cross-trained to deliver both services
 - a. 90% of all uniform personnel are assigned to Emergency Response.

- IV. Non-Emergency Services
 - a. Fire Inspection and Code Enforcement programs:
 - 1) Fire Company inspections =4,600
 - 2) Public Education presentations = 400
 - 3) Commercial and Multi-residential inspections =2,500
 - 4) Night inspections of public assemblies =2,100
 - 5) Plans review for new construction and major renovations =2,600
 - 6) Plans review for Special Events = 300
 - 7) Certificate of Occupancy inspections =1,100
 - 8) Certificate of Use inspections =1,000
 - 9) Special Master cases = 800
