- Median Property Value Approximately 125,000 in 1990; Majority 65% in the \$100,000 to \$200,000 range
- Racial Profile 91% White; 3.25% African American; 15% Hispanic origin includes whites (90% of 15%)
- Population 27,939 (2000 Census)
- Buildout 2010 Population projected at 32,000
- 75 homes constructed last year
- Major growth from now until buildout non-residential

# <u>RECENTLY APPROVED DEVELOPMENTS THAT MAY IMPACT SOUTHWEST</u> <u>RANCHES</u>

- **Country Glen** 300 Homes 65% Complete
- Cooper City Commerce Center East of Flamingo Road and North of Southwest 55<sup>th</sup>
   Street; light industrial/warehouse/office/showroom complex; 10 structures, 270,000 square
   feet; 50% occupied.
- New Postal Facility to be located at the northeast corner of Southwest 103<sup>rd</sup> Avenue and Stirling Road. Design of site plan is complete. This facility is to be 20,000 square feet in size and will serve Cooper City under a single, unified zip code. Completion expected early 2003.
- New Cooper City Police Station 27,000 sq. ft. facility completed last year at the corner of Embassy Drive N. and Stirling Road.

## FLAMINGO ROAD CORRIDOR

#### **RELIGIOUS INSTITUTIONS**

- **Temple Beth Emet** 14 acres South of Country Glen subdivision (under construction).
- Schott Center Residential training center for deaf and/or disabled individuals; west of Flamingo, south of Stirling Road. Dependent and independent living units for handicapped residents will be provided.
- Flamingo Road Baptist Church 17.25 acres at the northwest corner of Flamingo & Stirling Roads. Expansion of church preschool and day care approved by Broward County. Recently rezoned to Cooper City zoning.
- United Pentacostal Church 10 acres at 5201 S. Flamingo Road (.5 miles south of Griffin Road on west side of Flamingo Road). Proposed 17,000 sq. ft. addition .

#### VACANT LAND AT SW CORNER OF FLAMINGO AND GRIFFIN ROADS

- Approximately 8-acre tract under singular ownership
- Designated Estate on Land Use Plan Map
- Currently Zoned A-1, Agricultural
- No plans for development at this time.

#### **ANNEXATIONS**

 Currently working with residents of the unincorporated areas to facilitate annexation into the City.

# **VISION WORKSHOP FOR TOWN OF SOUTHWEST RANCHES**

- The County has mandated that all unincorporated areas of the County be annexed into adjacent municipalities by the year 2010.
- Unincorporated residents are finding it is not as economically feasible to remain unincorporated.

#### **ROADS**

#### **GRIFFIN ROAD WIDENING**

- The construction is to begin in July 2001. The project will widen Griffin Road to six lanes from University on the east to just east of Palm Avenue. Construction is expected to take about one year.
- Now in design stage of Griffin Road improvements from Flamingo Road to east of Southwest 100<sup>th</sup> Avenue
- Four lanes from east of Southwest 100<sup>th</sup> Avenue to Southwest 118<sup>th</sup> Avenue
- Six lanes from Southwest 118<sup>th</sup> Avenue to Flamingo Road
- Four lanes west to I-75 as part of the future project. New Bridge crossing of C-11 canal approximately 1400 feet west of 100<sup>th</sup> Avenue.

**TRAFFIC LIGHT AT FLAMINGO ROAD AND SW 49<sup>TH</sup> STREET** – Currently under construction at entrance to Country Glen Subdivision.

#### **FINANCE**

- Milage Rate 5.857 mills
- Annual Budget 16 million general fund; 23 million total budget

#### **UTILITIES**

- Deep injection well just completed to dispose of the by-product of our water treatment process as well as wastewater effluent. Drilled to a depth of 3,000 feet.
- New potable water system interconnect with City of Sunrise water system is planned in vicinity of 136<sup>th</sup> Avenue at west end of Country Glen subdivision. Construction to begin within two months. Will allow each City to serve other City's service area in case of emergency.
